## 2 Year Old Class Options

We have two class options for your 2 year old.  
The classes are identical in curriculum and design.  
Meet 9:15am – 11:15am

1. Guppies Class meets Tuesday and Thursday mornings,  
**Class is Full – email for waiting list availability**
2. Minnows Class meets Wednesday and Friday mornings,  
**Email for class availability**

These classes focus on learning how to be part of a group, taking turns and sharing; communicating your wants/needs to the teacher and classmates, and separating from the primary caregiver. We do pre-academic skills like language/vocabulary, listening, sitting for appropriate amounts of time, transitioning, and following a routine. We work on fine-motor (hand) skills and gross motor (large muscle) We sing, dance, play and do lots of art. The cost for this class is: \$390 per trimester or \$130 per month.

## 3 Year Old Class Options

We've two options for your child's 3-year-old Preschool experience!

1. Two Days a Week: Tuesdays and Thursdays, 9:00 AM – 11:30 AM.  
**CLASS IS FULL – email for waiting list availability**  
This is the class schedule that has traditionally been available here at St. Andrew's. The class will focus on play-based beginning academics, social/emotional growth, being part of a group, and becoming more independent. There will be lots of fine and gross motor work, music, art, and fun!  
The cost of this class is: \$390 per trimester or \$130 per month
2. Three Days a Week: Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays, 9:00 AM – 11:30 AM.  
**CLASS IS FULL – No waiting list**  
The curriculum is the same as the two day a week program. But, with an additional day, there is more time for everything, and some areas can be explored in greater depth. The cost of the class is: \$585 per trimester, or \$195 per month

The teachers at St. Andrew's are committed to giving your child a preschool experience that builds up him/her as a person, as well as a student. We use the Curriculum Standards provided by the Pennsylvania Department of Education to guide us as we design and implement the curriculum.
