- **Eligibility:** Children are eligible for enrollment in the Two-Year-Old Room (The Sprouts) no earlier than age Two Years, Seven Months, and must be potty trained or nearly potty trained. Although Staff will change accidents, our classroom is not intended for diapered children. We encourage you to contact the Director, Elizabeth Campbell, for further clarification. Children enrolled in Preschool Classes (ages 3 and 4 as of September, 2025) must be fully potty trained.
- **Immunizations:** We require all students be fully vaccinated to ensure that all children attending our school are adequately protected against outbreaks of vaccine preventable diseases. The following vaccinations are required for entrance (per PA Department of Health guidelines):
 - Four doses of DTaP** (one done on or after the 4th birthday)
 - Four doses of Polio** (fourth dose on or after the 4th birthday) *
 - Two doses of MMR** (measles, mumps, rubella)
 - Three doses Hepatitis B**
 - Two doses of Varicella** (chickenpox) or evidence of immunity

**a fourth dose is not necessary if the third dose was administered at age 4 or older, and at least 6 months after the previous dose*
- **Confirmations** will be emailed within two weeks, upon receipt of all completed paperwork.
- **Classes are filled on a first come / first served basis.**

The teachers at St. Andrew's Nursery School are committed to giving your child a preschool experience that builds him/her up as a person, as well as a student. We use the Curriculum Standards and Regulations provided by the Pennsylvania Department of Education to guide us as we design and implement the curriculum, as well as safety and staffing procedures.

Two-Year-Old Class

Children in the Two-Year-Old Class (*The Sprouts*) must be enrolled for a minimum of two days per week. There will be no more than eight children enrolled per day in this class. Class times are 9:15-11:15 each morning. Afternoon classes will be held from 12:45-2:45pm.

Children in *The Sprouts* are at an age of significant change and discovery. The class focuses on learning how to be part of a group, taking turns and sharing, communicating wants and needs to the teacher and classmates, and separating from the primary caregiver.

Our curriculum also includes pre-academic skills like language/vocabulary, listening, sitting for appropriate amounts of time, transitioning and following a routine. We work on fine-motor (hand) and gross motor (large muscle) skills. We sing, dance, play and do lots of creative (and sometimes messy) art. Our activities explore colors, shapes, counting and early math skills, phonetic exercises and recognizing both the first letter of each child's name as well as their name in print. Whenever possible, these skills are taught through play. As Albert Einstein once said, "*Play is the highest form of research.*"

Preschool Class

Children in the Preschool Class must be enrolled for a minimum of three days per week. There will be no more than twenty children enrolled per day in this class. Preschool classes meet each morning from 9-11:30am and from 12:30-3pm in the afternoon.

Our preschool class is a multi-age classroom designed to engage and grow the whole child academically and socially/emotionally. We focus on providing a warm, nurturing, and attentive school environment that eases young learners into school away from home and both prepares and excites them for their future in kindergarten. The students are learning through a blend of self-directed and teacher guided lessons and play as they develop positive interactions with friends and teachers. We incorporate early foundational math and literacy, art, science, music and movement, fine and gross motor skill development, discovery of the world around us, inquiry and problem solving into our hands-on learning. We strive to prepare children for their transition to kindergarten in a developmentally appropriate, fun way.

Payment Options: Families have the option of paying tuition on a monthly basis or by trimester. Monthly Payments are due on or before the Fifteenth (15th) of the month from August through April. Trimester Payments are due on or before August 15, November 15, and February 15.

Sibling Discount: If two or more siblings are enrolled, there will be a 12% discount for each child.

Church Members: There is a 5% discount for regularly worshiping members of St. Andrew's Church.

Payment in Full: A 10% discount is given to families that pay in full for the year by September 1st.
