Highlights of the March 10th Congregation Council Meeting.....

Treasurer: It was reported that, although February offerings were lower than expected, our numbers overall are more positive with the changes that have recently been made.

Property Team: The Hope House sidewalk railing will be prepped and repainted this Spring. The Team will be renting necessary equipment to repaint that parking lot. The roof over the Social Room needs to be replaced at a projected cost of \$50-60,000.

Community Care is considering putting together a team for the Highmark Walk on May 31st which will benefit ProJeCt of Easton. Pasta and rice still desperately needed for ProJeCt Food Pantry.

Nursery School: Funds have been donated for a portable sink in the smaller classroom. Both classrooms will be painted after the rummage sale. Staffing changes approved.

Worship and Music is discussing using projection in the worship space. Initial financial outlay will be made up after long term printing savings. Blessing of the Animals scheduled for May 17th.

There was discussion around using part of the parking lot as a temporary Pickleball court to be set up and taken down after use. It will cost the church \$50 for an annual insurance rider. A church member must be present and a "Chief Pickle" is needed to organize and schedule.

Council voted to discontinue using Bulk Mail. A \$360 annual fee must be paid by March 22nd and each mailing costs an additional \$40 or more in postage. The number of items being mailed can be cut significantly by eliminating mailing the monthly newsletters. Members can still print from email or the website, and printed copies will be available in the Narthex.
