God's love challenges us to find a way to include Saturday and Sunday Church goers, as we are reminded again that God loves all of his people.

#### **Ingathering**

At the time of this printing, the need is also increased due to the government shutdown which has halted SNAP payments and paychecks for federal workers. Your contributions are truly needed and appreciated. Food can always be dropped off at Hope House or left in the bins in the Narthex.
